

Dial-a-Truck

This is a service offered by the City of Summit to assist residents in disposing of bulky waste items.

To arrange for a collection, call us and we will be happy to schedule your bulky items for pick-up on the next available date.

- ◆ Once you have an appointment, it is not necessary that you call back to confirm.
- ◆ Only put out the items that you identified when you called.
- ◆ Small items will not be taken.
- ◆ Pick-up is "rain or shine"
- ◆ If we have to cancel the collection because of an emergency, we will call you as soon as possible to let you know the new date.

MUNICIPAL DISPOSAL AND PARKING PERMITS

Get a window sticker permit from the City Clerk's Office for eligible vehicles, entitling residents to free use of the Municipal Disposal Area to dispose of trash, brush and recycling. Call 273-6400 for details.

What is Dial-A-Truck???

DIAL-A-TRUCK is a bulky waste collection service of the Public Works Division of the Department of Community Services.



Beds and other similar furniture items must be disassembled first.

Every two weeks, the city collects those items that are too bulky or too heavy for you to take to the Transfer Station yourself.

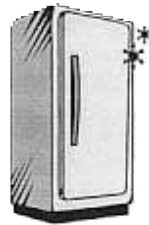
Mattresses, large pieces of furniture, dishwashers, and other heavy appliances are picked up by public works employees.

This is not a general clean-up service or a collection of trash and debris. We cannot pick up bags or boxes of trash – you may bring these to the Transfer Station in your own vehicle.



Dial-A-Truck is not the same as the recycling pickup. Call us and we'll send you a recycling schedule.

We also cannot take railroad ties, propane tanks, any construction or demolition materials, car parts, furnaces or heating boilers, or hazardous materials. We cannot take wood or metal fencing over 6 feet in length.



Remove this door before putting out at the curb – you might save a life.

If you put a refrigerator or freezer out for collection, please **BE SAFE** and remove the doors first! We've all heard too many stories about children who were trapped inside and suffocated.

DIAL-A-TRUCK operates at no charge to the resident. Because of its popularity, there may be a wait of as much as one month for service. (In contrast, some communities have a once-a-year collection for large items; others have none at all.)

In order to maintain the beauty and neat appearance of our neighborhoods, it is essential that residents do not leave any items for pick-up at the curb until DIAL-A-TRUCK is ready to collect them.



What to do . . .

- ◆ Call 273-6404 before putting anything out. We can answer your questions and will assign you a collection date.
- ◆ Set the approved items out at curbside no earlier than 24 hours before the scheduled collection.
- ◆ Only put out those materials that were approved by the Department of Community Services at the time you made your DIAL-A-TRUCK phone call.

Leaving unauthorized items at the curb is a violation of the Property Maintenance Code and may result in a summons and a fine.

This is not a general garbage and trash or "clean-up week" type service. *Non-bulky items will not be collected.*



Use your vehicle permit and take non-bulky items to the Municipal Disposal Area in your own vehicle.



Put very small items in with your weekly garbage and trash.
