<p><b>Type 10 - Municipal solid waste</b> - normal household trash etc.</p> <p><b>Type 13 - Bulky waste items</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Toys, furniture, small appliances, such as: blenders, toasters, radios, TV's etc.</li> <li>• Tires</li> <li>• Treated and painted lumber under 6 feet in length</li> <li>• Building materials not in excess of 40 gal. per trip, such as: shingles, shakes, sheetrock etc.</li> <li>• Dirty bi-metal and aluminum cans such as: empty and hardened latex paint cans, unopened food containers etc.</li> <li>• Windows with glass, broken or unbroken pane glass, mirrors, pottery/crockery</li> <li>• Textiles such as clothing, carpeting/padding</li> </ul> <p><b>Designated areas for:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Unpainted, untreated wood</li> <li>• Gas grill propane tanks</li> <li>• Corrugated cardboard and brown paper bags</li> <li>• Batteries, both automobile &amp; dry (flashlights, cameras, toys)</li> <li>• Computers/electronics</li> <li>• Fluorescent light tubes</li> </ul>	<p><b>Type 23 -Vegetative waste</b> such as: grass, brush, logs, leaves.</p> <p><b>Type 30 - Paper products</b> such as: books, magazines etc.</p> <p><b>Type 50 - Recyclable metals</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Aluminum, bi-metal, scrap iron, white goods, appliances with CFC's, such as: freezers, de-humidifiers, water coolers, refrigerators, air conditioners</li> </ul> <p><b>Type 60 - Recyclable plastics</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• P.E.T.E. &amp; HDPE (plastic items) with recycling logo numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, &amp; 7</li> </ul> <p><b>Type 61 - Concrete, asphalt, blocks, bricks</b></p> <p><b>Type 63 - Household hazardous waste</b> such as: asbestos, oil base paints, cleaners and solvents, thermostats, pesticides and herbicides, anti-freeze, gas, kerosene.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Medical waste such as bloodied gauze, intravenous needles, syringes.</li> <li>• Ammunition such as live rounds, bullets, shotgun shells.</li> </ul> <p><b>Textiles</b> – Clothing and shoes in usable condition</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Some of the above items may be accepted at the Compost and Recycling Area (see below)</p>

**COMPOST AND RECYCLING AREA**

<p><b>Type 23 - Vegetative Waste</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shrubs, brush and shrub trimmings.</li> <li>• Grass or leaves loose or in biodegradable paper bags</li> <li>• Logs and stumps not to exceed 6 inches in diameter</li> <li>• Branches and limbs for chipping</li> </ul> <p><b>Type 30 - Paper-</b> Newsprint, magazines, books, junk mail, mixed paper, office paper, ledgers, cardboard</p> <p><b>Type 40 - Glass</b> - Bottles/jars, clean and empty clear, amber (brown) and green glass such as juice containers, food and condiment jars (mayo, pickle etc.)</p> <p><b>Type 50 - Metal</b> - Aluminum, bi-metal cans, aluminum doors, scrap metal, white goods, such as ovens, stoves, metal cabinets; large appliances with CFC's such as: air conditioners, de-humidifiers, water coolers, refrigerators, and freezers</p> <p><b>Type 60 - Plastic-</b>All items with the recycling logo numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, &amp; 7 on the bottom such as soda, beverage, milk and water jugs, toys, etc.</p> <p><b>Type 61 -Concrete, asphalt, bricks and block</b> Limit of 2, 20 gallon cans per load</p> <p><b>Motor Oil</b> - Use the white recycling igloo</p> <p><b>Textiles</b> – Clothing and shoes in usable condition</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Window glass</li> <li>• Full or partially full glass bottles or cans</li> <li>• Heating oil tanks</li> <li>• 55 gal drums.</li> <li>• Ceramic-cups, crystal, clay flower pots, heat resistant ovenware, mirrors, pottery, dishes, glasses, tumblers, crockery, light bulbs.</li> <li>• Stumps over 6 inches in diameter</li> </ul>
